MOON TOWNSHIP TRANSITION TO AUTOMATED RECYCLING COLLECTION

The Moon Township Municipal Authority (MTMA) will be transitioning from manual collection of recycling to automated collection. Residents in single-family neighborhoods will receive a 64-gallon wheeled recycling container (Toter). Residents in multi-family neighborhoods will receive a 32-gallon Toter.

Toters will be distributed the week of November 7, 2022. The Toters will be owned and maintained by Waste Management. If you move, the Toters remain with the property.

Beginning November 14, 2022, recycling will only be collected if contained within the new recycling Toter provided by Waste Management, this includes cardboard. Other recycling containers will not be serviced..

Old style MTMA recycling containers will be collected and recycled if brought to the curb on collection day. Any other containers you want collected must be tagged with a large label requesting disposal.

- After receiving your Toter If you wish to schedule a one-time Toter size exchange – only **one** size exchange through 12/31/2023
- If the Waste Management Toter becomes damaged
- If collection does not occur on your scheduled day
- If you wish to purchase an additional 96-gallon recycling container for \$100
- If you did not receive your new Toter by November 11, 2022

Recycling remains limited to Aluminum cans, Tin cans, Plastics #1 and #2, bottles, jugs and jars only (no plastic food trays or plastic bags). Clean paper and clean corrugated cardboard (no stained cardboard such as pizza boxes or food-stained paper). Glass **may not** be placed in the recycling Toter. Glass bottles, jugs and jars can be recycled at 1115 Stevenson Mill Road, Moon Township, during normal work hours.
