= Solid Waste & Recycling Pickup



Pickup is one day late when the holiday observed by Waste Management falls on a weekday. When the holiday falls on Sunday, collection will be on Monday the next day.

The solid waste weekly pickup maximum limit is 15 refuse bags and 2 bulky waste items.

Customers desiring collection of a greater quantity should contact Waste Management to arrange a special collection.

Castlewood and Mooncrest began automated refuse collection in 2022. We expect automated refuse collection for all of Moon Township to begin in 2023, subject to new guidelines.

Recycling Guidelines

Curbside recycling collection will occur every week on the same day as regular curbside refuse pickup. Please refer to recycling information on the reverse side. Automated recycling collection began in 2022.

Household Electronic and Hazardous Waste Collection Program by Waste Management for MTMA solid waste customers (at no extra charge)

Automotive fluids and batteries, cleaners, paint, chemicals, electronic devices (computers, monitors, printers, TVs, phones, copiers, etc.) Call Waste Management at 800-449-7587 or visit www.WMAtYourDoor.com for appointment pickup. The list of recyclable material is as follows:

- (1) Aluminum cans.
- (2) Tin cans.
 - Do not recycle non-can items such as metal, foil, lawnmower blades, dog chains.
- (3) Plastics Clean bottles, jugs, jars only. No plastic bags. Do not put recycling materials in plastic bags. #1 PET (Polyethylene Terephthalate): Clear containers typically used for soft drinks and bottled water. No food trays.
 - #2 HDPE (High Density Polyethylene): Colored or translucent plastic. Typically used for milk or juice containers and common household chemicals, no plastic bags.

Plastics NOT RECYCLED

- Types #3 through #7, bags, film wrap, black PET trays or food trays of any type, plastic items such as, but not limited to flower pots, vinyl siding, records, VCR tapes.
- (4) Newspaper and Mixed Paper Any clean paper that can be torn, copier paper, soft back books, colored paper, file folders, insides of hardback books, bar line paper, magazines, mail inserts, business cards, catalogues, telephone books, poster board, envelopes, greeting cards, chip board (cereal and other similar boxes must be flattened to reduce volume).
 - <u>Do not recycle</u> pizza boxes and other paper with food or grease contamination. These are disposed of with regular trash. Do <u>not</u> recycle shredded or small pieces of paper, nor plastic covered paper such as milk cartons or paper drink cups.
- (5) Corrugated Cardboard May be flattened to reduce volume. All recycling materials, including cardboard must be placed inside the recycling toter for collection.

Other NOT RECYCLED

Glass <u>may not</u> be placed in the recycling toter. Glass may be recycled at the Moon Township Public Works garage at 1115 Stevenson Mill Road. Glass may also be disposed with regular trash. NO styrofoam. NO rubber products. These are disposed of with regular trash.

Materials Requiring Special Handling

Latex Paint	Dry up with kitty litter and dispose of with solid waste.
Carpet	Secure in bundles less than 4 ft in length. Bundles must weigh less than 40 lbs.
Refrigerators & air conditioners	Refrigerator door must be removed prior to pick-up. Freon must be removed by a licensed technician and a required sticker placed on unit.
Syringes and other "Sharps"	Should be placed in a puncture-resistant hard plastic or metal container. Container should be sealed in a securely fastened trash bag. Example: Laundry Detergent Containers.
Construction debris, logs, large branches are <u>not</u> collected	Call Waste Management at 1-800-866-4460 to arrange for a pick-up. Extra charge will apply.
Auto Parts & Tires ARE NOT COLLECTED	Contact auto salvage yard, scrap metal dealer, tire dealer.
